1. What are cookies and how does Nordbo Robotics use them?

- 1.1 A cookie is a small piece of information that will be stored on your hard disk until you delete it. Like most websites and applications, we use our own cookies and those of third parties, together with similar technologies, to make our websites and applications work, to offer you customized and personalized service, and to learn more about our users and their likely interests.

2.2 Performance, functional and targeting cookies

These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources, so we are able to measure and improve the performance of our site. These cookies help us understand which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors use our site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies, we will not know when you have visited our site.

2.3 Functional cookies

These cookies allow the provision of enhance functionality and personalization, such as videos and live charts. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our page. If you do not allow these cookies, then some or all of these functionalities may not function properly.

2.4 Targeting cookies

These cookies are set through our site by our advertising partners. These cookies can be used by our advertising partners to build a profile of your interests, and to show you relevant ads on other sites. They work by uniquely identifying your browser and device. If you do not allow these cookies, you will not experience our targeted advertising across different websites.
